

## ECE WAGE RATES COMPARED TO MARKET BASKET MEASURE (MBM) THRESHOLDS FOR 2 ADULTS/2 CHILDREN BY REGION

## ABOUT THIS CHART

This chart assesses the adequacy of Early Childhood Educator (ECE) wages by region. It compares government-subsidized wage rates for qualified educators working in licensed group child care centres participating in the Canada-Wide Early Learning and Child Care plan with the most recently available cost of living in their communities.

Calculations are based on government-subsidized wage rates for an ECE with a two-year diploma or equivalent, with approximately 5 years of experience, and working a 7.5-hour day for 261 days a year. Where annual earnings or work hours are reported as part of a wage grid, that amount is used. Not all jurisdictions
